As many of you have heard, the General Assembly deleted the “sworn” requirement from the submission of 1205’s to initiate an administrative suspension based upon a suspect’s BAC or refusal to submit to blood alcohol testing at the time of a DUI arrest.

The change was effective January 1, 2012, and the DDS has revised the 1205 form to remove the space for the notary’s signature.

Please feel free to use up your existing supplies of the old version of the form without swearing to the contents thereof.

The new forms just arrived from our printer, and the order form is attached for when you need to replenish your stock. I will send out another message when the new 1205-S forms come in, but you can continue to use old stock for them as well for now.
