- 1.) The Implied Consent Section of the Georgia Bureau of Investigation Division of Forensic Sciences approves alcohol screening devices for use as an investigative tool. These devices are approved for law enforcement personnel to use for the preliminary determination of alcohol concentration.
- 2.) The following devices are approved by the Division of Forensic Sciences for performing alcohol screening tests: the Alcoalyzer manufactured by Intoximeter, Inc.; the Alco-Sensor, Alco-Sensor II, Alco-Sensor III and RBT utilizing the Alco-Sensor III, Alco-Sensor IV and the Alco-Sensor FST manufactured by Intoximeter, Inc.; the A.L.E.R.T. system manufactured by Alcohol Countermeasure System, Inc.; the CMI Model SD-2 manufactured by Lion; the CMI Model SD-5, Intoxilyzer Model 300 and Model 400 manufactured by CMI, Inc.; the Lifeloc Model FC10 Alcohol Analyzer manufactured by Lifeloc Technologies, and the Alcotest 6510 and 6810 manufactured by Draeger Safety Inc.
- 2.) The above devices have been evaluated and have been found suitable for use as alcohol screening devices.
