Bibb Sheriff's Office H.E.A.T. grant renewed

The Georgia Governor's Office of Highway Safety has awarded the Bibb County Sheriff's Office a \$159,955 grant to help deputies fight drunk driving and aggressive driving.

The Highway Enforcement of Aggressive Traffic Grant will be used to help reduce impaired driving crashes, reduce excessive speeding, increase safety belt usage and educate motorists about traffic safety, according to a sheriff's office news release.

Bibb deputies formed the local H.E.A.T. unit four years ago after receiving its first grant in 2007.
