2. **GBI, Child Abduction Response Team orientation, February 13th, 2012, 1400 hours.**
3. **FAA Aviation Enforcement & Inspections, FAA Security, February 14th, 2012, 0800-1600:** Any agency with an airport in their jurisdiction would benefit from this course. Yes, local law enforcement can stop planes. I was amazed on the enforcement capabilities for local law enforcement. Student will receive training on: familiarization with general aviation operations, types of general aviation operation, federal agencies jurisdiction involving aviation, crimes related to general aviation, how to obtain information on aircraft, local jurisdiction pertaining to federal requirements, licensing requirements including examples, medical requirements and duration, foreign operations and requirements, hazards of being around aircraft, airport marking and signage (hold lines, etc), state laws and public utilities commission concerning pilots, conducting general aviation ramp checks - including regulatory authority, course includes a practical exercise at the airport. ****free course, the seats are filling up fast****
4. **International Police Mountain Bicycle Association Course, February 20th to 23rd, 2012.** Bicycle officers need to ride whenever and wherever they are needed. Proper training is essential to an officer's on-the-job performance and safety. It is also critical in reducing liability. The PC course provides bicycle officers with the skills they need to effectively serve their communities. The course is divided into eleven units: Bike Handling & Vehicular Cycling, Bike Fit, Group Riding, Hazard Recognition & Common Crashes, Obstacle Clearing & Riding Techniques, Patrol Procedures, Nighttime Patrol, Community Policing, Basic Maintenance, Legal Issues & Traffic Laws, and Fitness & Nutrition. This demanding class involves over 20 hours of on-bike time to develop and improve riding skills. **** limited free seats ****
5. **Car Safety Seat Certification, February 21st to February 24th, 2012.** Students will be certified as Child Passenger Safety Technicians (CPST). The course combines classroom instruction, hands-on work with car seats and vehicles, and a community safety seat checkup.
